






BAR EXAM APPLICATION DEADLINES JULY 2020


NY	 Opens: April 1 Filing Deadline: April 30 Online application
CA	 Opens: March 1 Filing Deadline: April 1 Online application
D.C.	 Opens: April Filing Deadline: Typically first week in May Online application
MA	 Opens: March Filing Deadline: Typically first Friday in May Paper application

UNIFORM BAR EXAMINATION (UBE)

- Over 30 States have adopted the UBE
- Minimum passing scores vary by State
- Jurisdiction-specific component may be required for admission







*Applicants must achieve a passing score on the MPRE before they may sit for the bar in Massachusetts.

MULTISTATE PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY EXAM (MPRE)


Changes beginning 2020

Administered 3 times a year (March, August & November)
 Administered on two weekdays per administration
 Computer-based exam at Pearson VUE testing centers
 New Accommodations Process

2020 registration process and test day policies will be posted in late November

Start compiling your documents as early as your

1L summer employment

- Provide Affidavits of all law-related employment:
 - Summer Associate Employment
 - RA & TA Support for Faculty here at CLS
 - Externships & Clinics
 - Paid and Unpaid Internships
- Provide Affidavits for each pro bono project that satisfies the 50-hour requirement
- (2) original good moral character affirmations

Mail complete packet to appropriate Appellate Division

- Submit to Registration Services for certification*:
 - Skills Form Affidavit
 - Form Law School Certificate

*Documents will be mailed directly to Appellate Division

Online Application

Start any time after registering as a law student but no later than the beginning of your last year of law study





HANDWRITING SAMPLES

Registration Services is authorized to certify handwriting samples for bar applications that have this requirement (e.g., New York State).



OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

 Registration Services is authorized to forward an official copy of your Columbia University transcript to the various state bar organizations.
 You do not need to make a separate request.

FINGERPRINTING

Some jurisdictions require applicants for admission to the bar to provide their fingerprints,


Check your state's bar requirements:

ADA TESTING ACCOMMODATIONS COMMON TESTS

NY (UBE)

Filing Deadline: April 30 Encouraged to file as early as 6 months prior to exam administration (February)

<u>NYLE</u>

Filing Deadline: 90 days prior to exam date

CA

Filing Deadline: April 1 Encouraged to file as early as possible

<u>D.C.</u>

Filing Deadline: May 3

<u>MA</u>

Filing Deadline: May 1 Encouraged to file as early as 6 months prior to exam administration (February)

<u>MPRE</u>

Must apply <u>prior</u> to registering for exam. NCBE will begin accepting requests

on October 21, 2019, for 2020 exam administrations.

NOTARY PUBLIC

Some bar documents may need to be notarized.
