New in 2021, the Global Law and Business Seminar is a one-week professional education program for global business lawyers, arbitration professionals, judges, prosecutors, defense counsel, and others.

The non-credit program offers 16 hours of instruction on Corporate Law, International Arbitration, and Public Integrity Law. Participants receive a Statement of Participation signed by the Dean, and may attend optional lunchtime lectures, networking opportunities, and visits to sites of professional and cultural interest.

The program fee is \$2,500. On-campus housing is available on a limited basis for an additional fee. Individual applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis as of September 1.
