PUBLIC INTEREST JOB SEARCH BASICS

STEP 1: MEET WITH AN SJI ADVISER TO CONSTRUCT A JOB SEARCH PLAN

Make an appointment on **<u>Symplicity</u>** with a Social Justice Initiatives (SJI) adviser. Our staff includes specialists in public interest, government, and human rights. As you narrow your focus, you can meet with the adviser who best matches your interests.

STEP 2: EXPLORE JOB SEARCH RESOURCES

The SJI Job Search Tools page links to public interest job search resources, including:

- **PSJD.org** for public interest jobs and employer profiles. Tip: Sign up for updates on jobs that fit your search!
- <u>Symplicity</u>
 - For jobs employers send to us directly.
 Tip: Watch for SJI's weekly job blasts!
 - For students' summer internship evaluations.
 (Select "My Account," then "Evaluations," and then "Search.")
 Tip: Find older evaluations in LawNet's Public Interest Database. (See "Student Services)
- <u>The Arizona Guide (Government Honors and Internship Handbook)</u> for federal, state, and local government internships. (password: publicservice)
- SJI's New York Public Interest Index for New York-area employers listed by subject area.
- <u>IL Summer Judicial Internships and Clerkships 101 Resources</u> on Courseworks for materials to help you research, apply, and prepare for summer judicial internships.

STEP 3: PREPARE YOUR MATERIALS AND APPLY

As you draft your application materials, use the <u>Public Interest Job Search Toolkit</u> as your guide. Work with your SJI adviser or submit materials to the <u>1L Resume and Cover Letter</u> <u>Review Portal (under "Resume Review Portals"</u>).
