Spring 2024 Emergency Accommodations re: Credit/Fail (Cr/F) Elections

Please find details of the expanded Cr/F options recently communicated by the Dean:

- 1Ls: You have the option to elect any course in this spring term as Cr/F. That is, you may elect zero, one, two, or all your courses as Cr/F. (This amends Rule 3.1.2 to include 1Ls and waives Rule 3.1.2.2). All courses, including foundation courses, electives, and Legislation and Regulation are eligible for Cr/F. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.4.) Further, your election is not subject to the ten-credit limit on Cr/F elections. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.3.)
- **2Ls and 3Ls**: You have the option to elect **any** course in this spring term as Cr/F. That is, you may elect zero, one, two, or all your courses as Cr/F. (This amends Rule 3.1.2 and waives Rule 3.1.2.2). **All** courses, including foundation courses, electives, Professional Responsibility and Legislation and Regulation are eligible for Cr/F. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.4.) Further, your election is not subject to the ten-credit limit on Cr/F elections. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.3.)
- LLMs: You have the option to elect **any** course in this spring term as Cr/F. That is, you may elect zero, one, two, or all your courses as Cr/F. (This amends Rule 3.1.2 to include LLMs and waives Rule 3.1.2.2). All courses, including foundation courses, Professional Responsibility, Legislation and Regulation, courses that require papers or other final projects, and bar-qualifier courses are eligible for Cr/F. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.4.) Further, your election is not subject to the ten-credit limit on Cr/F elections. (This waives Rule 3.1.2.3.)
- For all students: Students may only choose Cr/F in courses for which exams or final assessments have not yet occurred. Grades already submitted, and courses in which final exams or papers have already been conducted, are **not** eligible to be converted to Cr/F. All Rules aside from those noted above—including Rules regarding grading, grading curves, and honors determinations—remain in force.

Cr/F election deadlines for all students:

- For an examination that you may select to take on **any day** of the examination period (April 29th-May 7th) (i.e., an "Any Day" exam), you must email <u>Registration Services</u> with your Cr/F election by no later than **Saturday, April 27th at 11:59 pm EDT**.
- For an examination scheduled on **Monday April 29th**, you must email <u>Registration Services</u> with your Cr/F election by no later than **Saturday, April 27th at 11:59 pm EDT**.
- For an examination on **any later scheduled date**, you must email <u>Registration Services</u> with your election by no later than **11:59 pm EDT on the third calendar day prior to the scheduled date of examination or assessment**. That is, for examinations on Tuesday, April 30, the deadline is Saturday, April 27; for Wednesday May 1, the deadline is Sunday April 28, and so on.
