Officials & politicians in scores of countries abuse their public offices for personal gain they manipulate the legal system to serve their goals.

A key 2015 TI priority is to campaign for No Impunity. We must UNMASK the corrupt.

NO IMPUNITY

- 1. Promote freedom of information & transparency in every aspect of public life.**
- 2. Campaign for honest & independent judges and public prosecutors.**
- 3. Demand publicly accountable politicians and officials.**
- 4. Unmask the corrupt – end “holding company” opacity; enforce anti-money laundering.**
- 5. Campaign for honest & independent judges and public prosecutors.**

Bribe-Payers

- **Too often – corporations are willing bribe-payers. 41 countries enacted the OECD Anti-Bribery Convention, but more than one-half of them have done little or nothing to enforce it – a key TI 2015 campaign is to secure change and create a global corruption free level-playing field.**

Peace, Security and Corruption

- Without impunity, there will not be peace and security.**
- From insecurity created by corrupt police, to global insecurity promoted by corrupt regimes – the world is a far less secure – and a more violent - place because of corruption.**
- Reforms demand that we understand these issues – today, they attract too little attention.**
